SECTION C - RIDERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- I understand that riding at any standard has inherent risk and that all horses may react unpredictably on occasions.
- I may fall off and could be injured. I accept that risk.
- I understand that instructions are given for my safety and agree to follow instructions given to me by staff and instructors at the riding school.
- I reserve the right not to ride a horse allocated to me
- Any information provided by the client that is deemed inaccurate will be recorded and we will request a new client registration form to update our records.
- I understand that wearing an appropriate riding hat and body protector may reduce the severity of an injury should an accident happen and agree that I will always wear a riding hat whilst riding, leading and grooming horses at the riding school. I understand it is my choice whether or not I wear a body protector.
- I understand that the riding school will make decisions based on information I give them and agree to always be honest and volunteer information about:
 - my abilities and riding experience
 - any previous riding accidents
 - any medical condition(s) which may affect my ability to ride
- I understand that children are at particular risk around horses and agree that I will keep any children that I am responsible for, under close supervision when they are not being instructed by the riding school.
- I understand that the riding school may refuse my request to ride for safety and operational reasons.

- As riding is a risk sport we recommend that you take out personal accident insurance.
- We reserve the right to withdraw any client who we feel is either unsafe or unsuitable. A decision will be made by a qualified instructor or management and is final.
- Clients are very welcome to help on the yard but please ensure you have been inducted by a member of our staff before doing so and we recommend you have adequate personal accident insurance. Your choice to ride or help on the yard is voluntary so please accept that you do so at your own risk and do not hold the riding centre or its employees responsible for accidental damage or injury (excluding accidents caused by negligence).
- From time to time we take photos of the horses and lessons which we use for promotional purposes - in leaflets, on our website and in social media. If you would prefer not to have an image of you used in this way please tick this box
